Sunday School Teachers




Are you looking for ways to get more involved in our church? How about investing in our church's children by being a Sunday school


TURKEY FESTIVAL FLOAT

Hurricane Harvey Relief

There are a number of ways we can help with Hurricane Harvey relief efforts through UMCOR (United Methodist Committee On Relief).



Pray: Pray for the people of flood-infected areas, for the families of the lost, and for first responders.

Cleaning and Hygiene Kits: UMCOR has invited United Methodists to prepare hygiene kits and cleaning buckets. Missouri currently has approximately 500 cleaning buckets that will be diverted to needed areas of the country when UMCOR calls. Help replenish our stock to enable swift response for this and future disasters. Visit UMCOR to learn how to make a cleaning kit (\$65 value) or a hygiene kit (\$12 value).
