
POTLUCK LUNCH

The United Methodist Women's group meets on the first Wednesday of the month at 1:00 pm in the fellowship hall. Women of all ages are invited.





There are still a few jars of Apple Butter left in the coffee room. Jars are \$5 each, and proceeds go towards our new Church Improvement fund.




Ride To Church
